For those planning to run for local positions:

Noon, June 1, 2017 is the deadline to file for an office. Kansas House Bill 2104 moves elections to the fall and also raises the filing fee from \$5.00 to \$20.00. In lieu of the filing fee, a petition may be circulated with 10 signatures being required to run for a city office. Paperwork is available at the City Hall, but must be filed with the County Clerk. If a Primary Election is needed it will take place on Tuesday, August 1, 2017. The General Election will take place on Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

Changes in Robinson City trash rates: Because of increased rates at the Brown County Transfer Station and the need to maintain city equipment, the trash rate will change from \$16 to \$20 for once-weekly pick up and from \$21 to \$28 for twice-weekly pick up. The last rate increase for trash pick up was in 2015.
