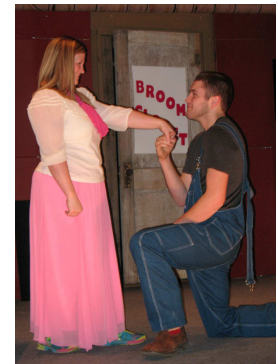
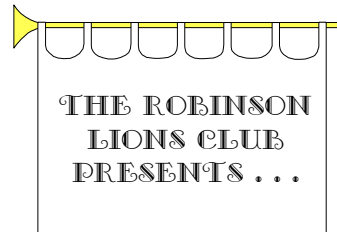
As has been tradition in the past, the Scouts will serve redeye and popcorn.

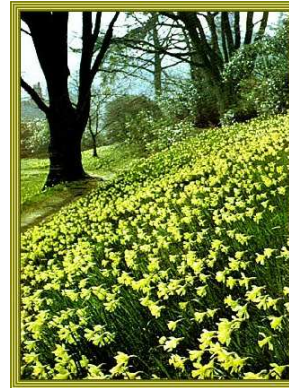
