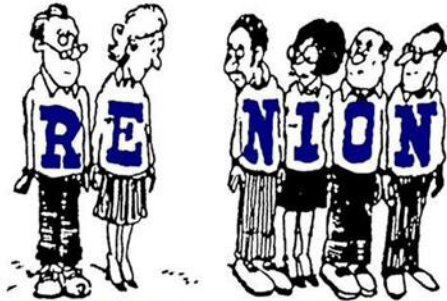
ROBINSON ALUMNI REUNION
